


## VOLUNTEER SPOTLIGHT

# SUPPORT THE SAFE ACT!

***Every horse is just one bad sale away from the slaughterhouse.***

## **What is the SAFE Act?**

The Safe Act is the acronym for the Safeguard American Food Exports Act (H.R. 961/S.2006).

## **What does the SAFE Act do?**

The Safe Act would prevent horse slaughter factories from opening in the US and end the export of horses abroad for slaughter for human consumption.



## **Why Support the SAFE Act?**

Horse slaughter is fundamentally cruel and cannot be completed in a "humane" way. Horses are transported in overcrowded trucks, sometimes for days, without food or water. Many horses are injured, and some even die during transit. Once at the slaughterhouse, the horses endure numerous blows to the head before being slaughtered. While this action alone is sufficient to stop horse slaughter, there are other factors, too. Horses in the US are not raised for consumption. Many receive unregulated toxic substances over the course of their lives. Some of these substances can cause potentially fatal diseases in humans. There is no tracking system to identify what substances a horse has been given over its life span.

Everyone who wants to permanently stop the slaughter of America's horses and eliminate transportation of equines from the U.S. to Canada, Mexico, and any other country for the purpose of slaughter needs to become proactive and contact their elected officials.
